AWARDS AND FELLOWSHIPS

The awards that are probably of most interest to ANZMAG members are **the ANZMAG medals**, for which nominations are currently open. There are two awards **The ANZMAG medal** is open to all members of the Society meeting the eligibility criteria and is designed to recognise outstanding contributions to magnetic resonance. The **Young Investigator Award** is available for Society members who have been awarded a PhD no more than 15 years prior to the closing date for nominations, except in the case of significant interruptions to their research career. Each award comes with a medal and a cash prize. Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships are internationally competitive, merit-based scholarships provided by the Australian Government that support citizens around the world to undertake study, research and professional development in Australia and for Australians to do the same overseas. Applications for the 2016 round are expected to open mid-April. The website where all information will be listed is at https://internationaleducation.gov.au/Endeavour program/Scholarships-and-Fellowships/Pages/default.aspx however, as anybody who has ever written and form of fellowship application knows, they always take much longer than you think so it might be worth starting to contact potential hosts labs now and work up a draft proposal or idea so that you can hit the ground running once applications open.

The Australian Academy of Science is currently inviting applications from Australian researchers for the France-Australia Science Innovation Collaboration (FASIC) program Early Career Fellowships. The Early Career Fellowships are a platform for bilateral collaboration in science jointly managed and funded by Australia details the governments of and France. SOFTWARE NEWS

Chenomx NMR Suite 8.1 was released earlier this year (for background on this please see http://chenomx.com/software/software.php?pageID=93). While primarily a metabolomics software tool (and a bit of a resource hog) it is a nice piece of kit and the price has been 'adjusted' recently. For example, a one year subscription for academics has now dropped to ~ US\$ 1250. This is still a decent amount of cash, especially at today's exchange rates, but it's quite a drop from the US\$ 2800 per year they charged in 2013. Upgrades are also now cheaper if you have an older version that would like to update (http://chenomx.com/software/software.php?pageID=62#purchase).
